

The Triangle

with a plain border and a two-colour check centre

P&B Wools Pattern No. 320, published by Patons & Baldwins Limited, c.1934–35

MATERIALS

2 oz Dark, 1 oz Light — Patons Beehive Fingering 3-ply, Patonised

Two No. 12 and two No. 10 Beehive or Queen Bee needles, measured by Beehive gauge

A medium crochet hook

You must use the P&B brand recommended above to be sure of a successful result.

MEASUREMENT

Length from centre to point: 14 inches

TENSION

7½ sts. and 9½ rows to one square inch on No. 10 needles, measured over stocking stitch.

Stitches are slipped knitwise throughout. Do not break off wool but carry it up side of work, thus preventing many ends.

TO KNIT

Using No. 12 needles and Dark, cast on 317 sts.

Continue decreasing in this manner until the row "K.1, (K.2 tog., K.131, K.2 tog., K.1) twice" has been worked (269 sts.).

Next row — K.

Change to No. 10 needles, join in Contrast and proceed as follows:

1st row (Light) — K.2, * sl.1 knitwise, K.2, rep. from * to end.

2nd row (Light) — K.2 tog., w.ft., (sl.1 knitwise, P.2) 43 times, sl.1, (P.2 tog., sl.1) twice, (P.2, sl.1) 43 times, K.2 tog.

3rd row (Dark) — K.

4th row (Dark) — K.1, (K.2 tog., K.127, K.2 tog., K.1) twice.

5th row (Light) — K.3, (sl.1, K.2) 41 times, (sl.1, K.3) twice, sl.1, (K.2, sl.1) 41 times, K.3.

6th row (Light) — K.1, P.2 tog., (sl.1, P.2) 41 times, sl.1, P.1, P.2 tog., sl.1, P.2 tog., P.1, sl.1, (P.2, sl.1) 41 times, P.2 tog., K.1.

7th row — As 3rd row.

8th row (Dark) — K.1, (K.2 tog., K.123, K.2 tog., K.1) twice.

9th row (Light) — K.4, (sl.1, K.2) 39 times, sl.1, (K.4, sl.1) twice, (K.2, sl.1) 39 times, K.4.

10th row (Light) — K.1, P.2 tog., P.1, (sl.1, P.2) 40 times, P.2 tog., (sl.1, P.2 tog.) twice, (P.2, sl.1) 40 times, P.1, P.2 tog., K.1.

11th row — As 3rd row.

12th row (Dark) — K.1, (K.2 tog., K.119, K.2 tog., K.1) (centre st.), K.2 tog., K.119, K.2 tog., K.1 (245 sts.).

**** 13th row (Light)** — K.2, * sl.1, K.2, rep. from * to end.

14th row (Light) — K.2 tog., patt. to centre 5 sts., P.2 tog., sl.1, P.2 tog., patt. to last 2 sts., K.2 tog.

15th row — As 3rd row.

16th row (Dark) — K.1, K.2 tog., K. to centre 5 sts., K.2 tog., K.1, K.2 tog., K. to last 3 sts., K.2 tog., K.1.

17th row (Light) — K.3, patt. to centre 7 sts., K.3, sl.1, K.3, patt. to last 3 sts., K.3.

18th row (Light) — K.1, P.2 tog., patt. to centre 7 sts., P.1, P.2 tog., sl.1, P.2 tog., P.1, patt. to last 3 sts., P.2 tog., K.1.

19th row — As 3rd row.

20th row — As 16th row.

21st row (Light) — K.4, patt. to centre 9 sts., K.4, sl.1, K.4, patt. to last 4 sts., K.4.

22nd row (Light) — K.1, P.2 tog., P.1, patt. to centre 9 sts., P.2, P.2 tog., sl.1, P.2 tog., P.2, patt. to last 4 sts., P.1, P.2 tog., K.1.

23rd row — As 3rd row.

24th row — As 16th row. **

Rep. from ** to ** until 77 sts. remain. Break off Light.

Change to No. 12 needles and rep. 15th and 16th rows until 5 sts. remain.

Next row — K.2 tog., K.1, K.2 tog.

Next row — K.3 tog.

Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

With wrong side of work facing, block fabric by pinning out round edges. Press fabric using a warm iron and damp cloth.

Sew in ends. Using Dark, work a row of d.c. along long edge.
